- GSFS (Global Standard for Food Safety) knowledge desirable
- Experience in interacting with third party auditors

This position will be responsible for ensuring the implementation of all plant and food safety programs; as well as verifying that outgoing products processed meet the company's Quality Assurance & Food Safety Requirements and adhere to customer specifications. Scope of responsibility also includes monitoring plant's environmental programs. This position reports to the Manager of Alaska QA Programs and the plant manager.

### **Primary functions include:**

- Overseeing plant's thermal process operations (canning lines)
- Ensuring that OB plant training programs are carried out
- Conducting daily document review (including environmental compliance monitoring)
- Responsible for online and finished product inspections
- Adapting corporate issued policies (policy writing with Corp. QA oversight)
- Interacting with regulatory, customer, and other third party auditors (plant tours)
- Ensuring the implementation of proper corrective actions during non-conforming situations

- Supervises QA staff responsible for thermal process operations (CCP related activities)
- Provides support to Plant Manager and Maintenance department (assists with decision making in regards to quality and food safety programs)
